The Connecticut State Police in conjunction with The University of New Haven Center for Forensic Investigation of Trafficking in Persons and the Federal Bureau of Investigation will be offering a **free** ½ day seminar on Domestic Minor Sex Trafficking in Schools.

Training Description:

The seminar is designed to provide law enforcement officers with the skills necessary to identify, investigate and interview victims of Domestic Minor Sex Trafficking (DMST). The first module of the seminar will provide law enforcement officers with an overview of the Connecticut statutes regarding DMST, what red flags to look for when identifying DMST, the tactics trafficker's use and why victims stay with the trafficker. The second module of the seminar will provide law enforcement officers with the necessary skills to effectively interview victims of DMST.

Who Should Attend:

The seminar is intended **only** for Law Enforcement Officers, but especially for Investigators, Youth Officers and School Resource Officers (SROs) addressing the inherent problem of Domestic Minor Sex Trafficking in our schools. Those who attend the training seminar will be eligible for POSTC Review Training Credit as follows: Curriculum Area V: Criminal Investigation, 4 hours.
